Strength of Schedule Analysis

In the previous table, I calculated the strength of schedules for the KFFL.

The best measure of a team's success is the total points scored. This means that you drafted and played the right players. Win/loss depends on how good your opponents were that week. Since we do not play each team the same number of times, some teams will have more difficult schedule than others will. Points against are a good measure of the strength of your opponents to date on the week they played you, but it doesn't measure the difficulty of your schedule to date or in the future.

Season to Date Opponent Scoring - this is the sum of the total points scored by each of your opponents through game 7.

Rank - this is the rank of your opponents scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest. This is a measure of how good your opponents have been so far in the season. Some interesting notes:

- The Wandering Snails have had the hardest schedule to date, and the Heaving Puffers have had the easiest schedule to date, based on opponent strength.
- The Wandering Snails have had only the seventh most points scored against them, and the Heaving Puffers have had the sixth most points against them, indicating that the opponent strength is not the indicator of how difficult their season has been.
- The Albino Rhinos have had the most points scored against them to date, followed closely by the Nancy Boys and Devil Dogs. Let the second-half beat-downs commence.
- The Mountain Oysters have had an amazingly low number of points scored against them, a little more than half the points scored against the Dogs and Boys.

This means that the Puffers opponents stepped up against them, scoring more than their average, and the Snails opponents laid down against them, scoring less than their average.

Remaining Games Opponent Scoring - this is the sum of the total points scored by each of your opponents for game 8 through 14.

Rank - this is the rank of your opponents scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest. This is a measure of how good your opponents will be for the rest of the season. Some interesting notes:

- The Heaving Puffers have the most difficult schedule remaining, followed by the Nancy Boys (yay!). The Puffers go from the easiest to the most difficult schedule.
- The Bad Monkeys have the easiest schedule remaining (good news for the Monkeys).
- Team Blanstein, the Bad Monkeys, and the Albino Rhinos may improve their records because of easier second-half schedules. The Mountain Oysters, the Heaving Puffers, and the Wandering Snails may not fare as well because of tougher second-half schedules.
- The Nancy Boys faced the second most difficult schedule in the first half, and will have the second most difficult schedule in the second half. Fans are throwing toilets in Nancy Boys Stadium already.

Strength of Schedule Analysis

Entire Season Opponent Scoring - this is the sum of the total points scored by each of your opponents for the season.

Rank - this is the rank of your opponents scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest. This is a measure of how good your opponents will be for the entire season. Some interesting notes:

- The Bad Monkeys have the easiest overall season schedule, followed by Team Blanstein.
- The Wandering Snails have the most difficult overall season schedule, followed by the Nancy Boys.
- The difference between the easiest and most difficult schedule is much more significant this year, about seven points per game (7.14).

Season to Date Opponent Points Over Average – the points per game opponents scored above or below their average scoring

Rank - this is the rank of your opponents scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest.

To measure whose opponents have "stepped up" against them, I calculated the total points per week for all opponents above the opponents average weekly scoring. A high positive number (like 60.1 for Team Blanstein) means that Blanstein's opponents have scored more than 60 points more against the Monkeys than their average against the rest of their opponents (about 8.6 points per game). This means that even though Blanstein had the sixth most difficult schedule so far, their opponents stepped up and scored the fourth highest total. In the same way, a large negative number (like -107.6 for the Squatting Dungbeetles) means that opponents scored much less than their average, and the Dung have the eighth lowest points against and yet have the fourth most difficult schedule based on opponent strength.

Standard Deviation – the standard deviation of scoring for each team through week 7

Rank - this is the rank of the consistency of your scoring, with 1 being the most consistent and 10 being the least consistent.

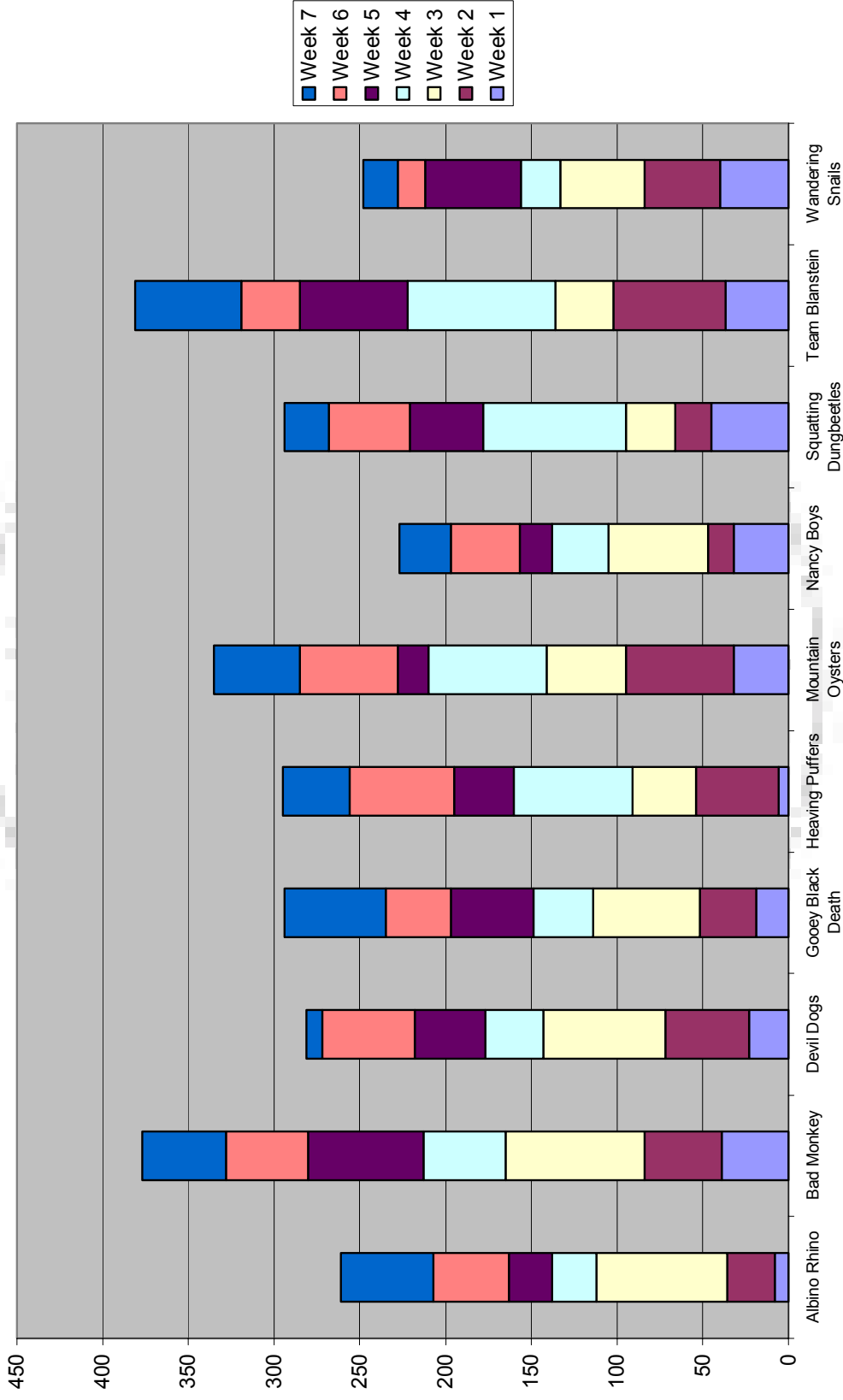
Lastly, consistent scoring week to week usually means a good record, depending on how much scoring occurs. Standard deviation measures how much scoring varies week to week. A low number means more consistency. Some interesting notes:

- The Albino Rhinos have the least consistent scoring, and are 3-4. This high standard deviation is probably due to the snowman that they threw in week 1.
- The Heaving Puffers have the most consistent scoring.

Summary – this year, comparing the Total Points rank with the standings, it seems that the two stats correlate well, with luck playing a factor with few teams. The Monkeys and Dogs may deserve to be up a notch, and the Oysters, Rhinos and Snails may deserve to be down a notch. My prediction is that Blanstein and the Monkeys finish the season 1-2, and the Oysters take the third spot. The fourth spot is still within the reach of most teams, and anything can happen in the playoffs. Devil Dogs and Nancy Boys duke it out for the Toilet Bowl.

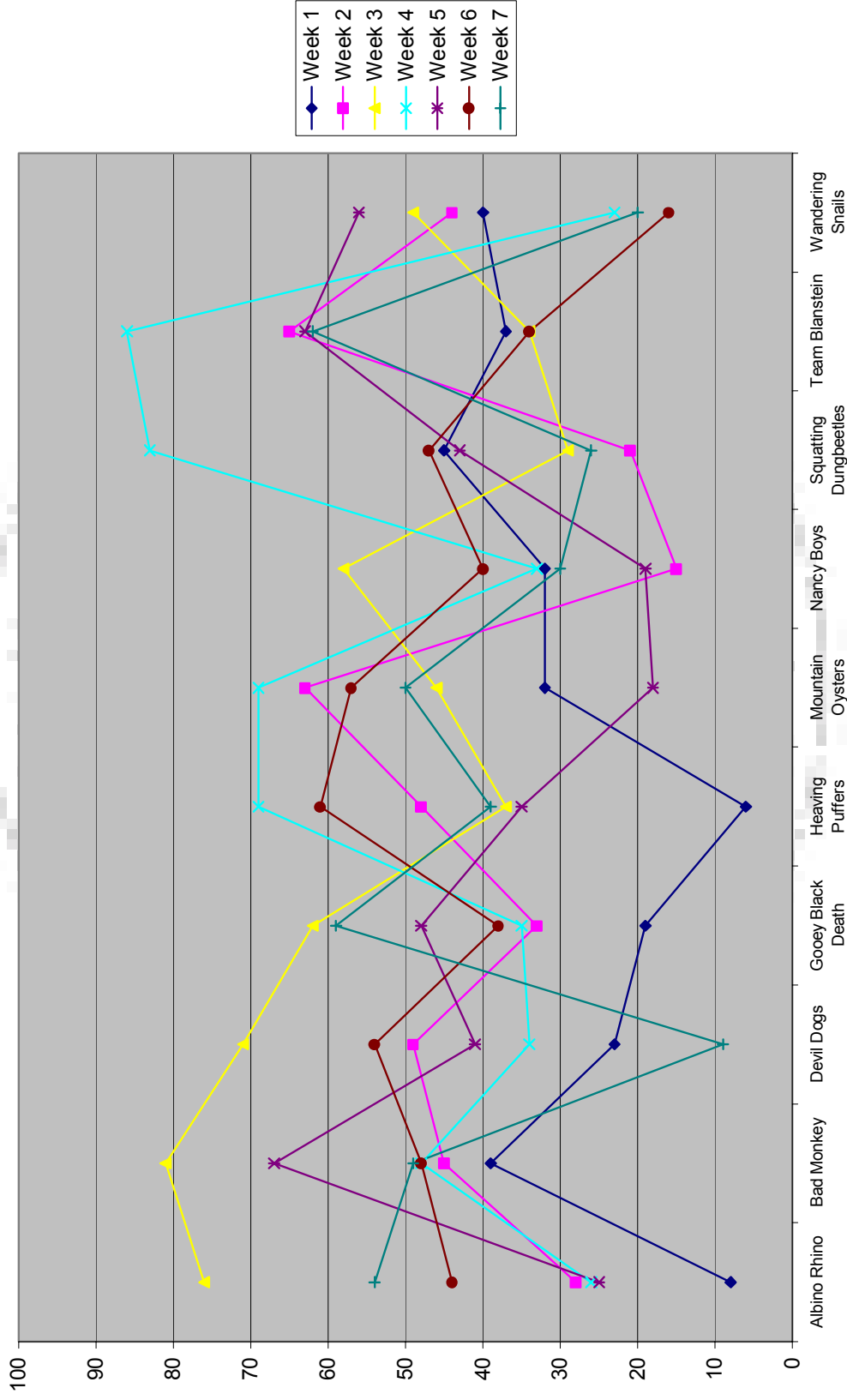
Weekly Scoring

Scoring by Week



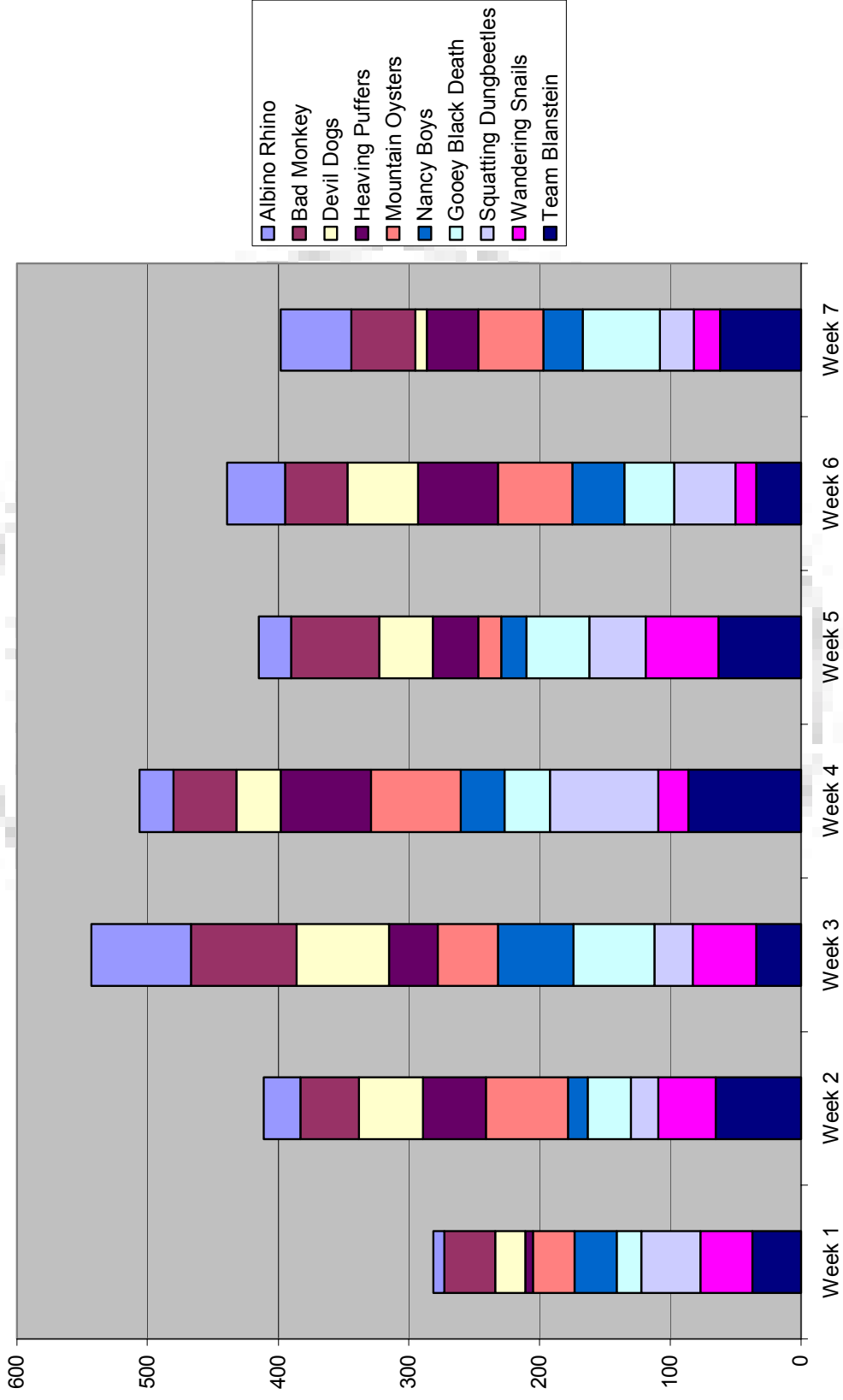

Scoring by Week



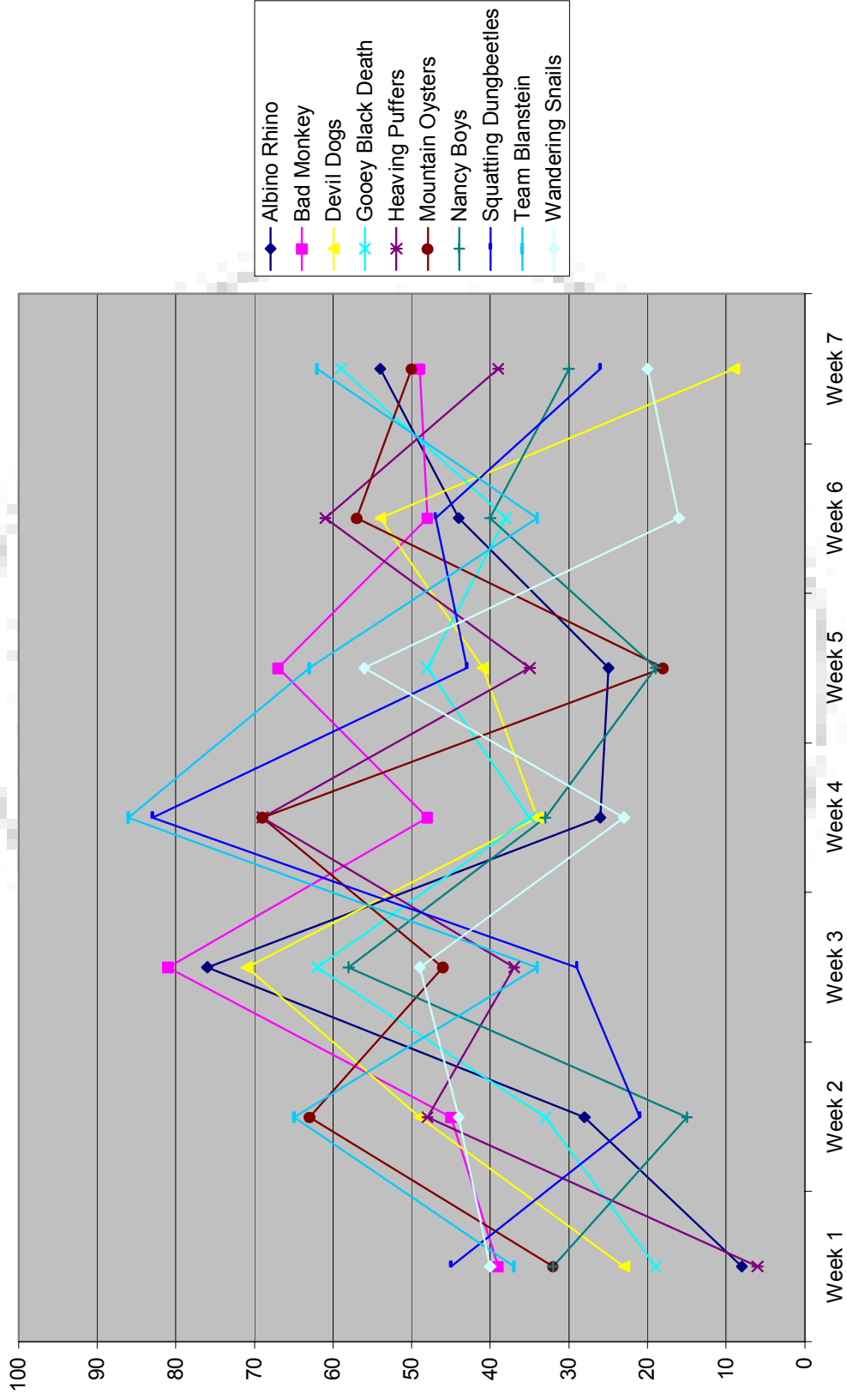
Weekly Scoring

Coaching Effectiveness

The three functions of a fantasy football coach are the draft (who do I want on my team?), player management (who do I start this week?) and player moves (who do I keep and who do I drop?). The effectiveness any of these functions really cannot be evaluated until the season is over. Also, how do you factor in injuries, contract holdouts, mid-season trades, and other situations that cannot be anticipated at draft day? Nonetheless, I will attempt to quantify the effectiveness of each team's coaching through the midpoint in the season.

Draft - The total points scored by the team, regardless of who was started, will be biased by some teams holding backup kickers and defensive players (low scoring backups), while other teams having additional skill position players (high scoring backups). The best indicator of the quality of a draft is the sum of the points each week that can be generated by the best possible lineup from that team that week. This will be slightly skewed by injuries, and will ignore improving teams and teams that are going into the dumpster, but will provide an idea of who has been able to field the best possible lineup for the first half of the season.

Starters Scoring - this is the sum of the total points scored by your starting lineup through game 7.

Rank - this is the rank of your starters scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest

Best Team Scoring- this is the sum of the total points scored by the best possible starting lineup for your team each week through game 7. This is an indication of who had the best draft.

Rank - this is the rank of your best team scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest

Some interesting notes:

- The Starter's scoring generally correlates with record, with a couple of exceptions. The Bad Monkeys should be a step higher than they are according to their scoring, along with the Dogs, and the Oysters, Rhinos and Snails have a better record than their total scoring reflects.

Player Management - To evaluate player management, I compare the actual points scored with the best possible lineup, determined above. The percentage of the total actually scored versus total possible indicates how effective the player selection has been. To factor out issue of backups like quarterbacks, kickers, etc. who score points but only one can be played every week, I will take the ratio of actual scoring over the worst possible team divided by the difference between best team and worst team.

Some interesting notes:

- The best team matches pretty closely with actual scoring, except for a couple of teams. The Nancy Boys have the lowest actual scoring, but the 6th overall best team, because of missing a couple of big QB performances. The Rhinos have the 8th highest scoring but the third highest potential. The Monkeys, the Puffers, and the Goo all have higher rank for actual scoring than best team, indicating really good coaching, or a lack of depth.

Worst Team Scoring- this is the sum of the total points scored by the worst possible starting lineup for your team each week through game 7. This will be used to factor out differences in rosters.

Rank - this is the rank of your worst team scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest.

Coaching Effectiveness

Percent of Best – this is the percentage of the best possible team that you actually scored. Perfect player management would result in 100%. Picking the worst possible players will result in 0%. This is an indication of who managed their players best.

Rank - this is the rank of your percentage of best possible scoring, with 1 being the best and 10 being the worst.

Some interesting notes:

- The Nancy Boys and the Albino Rhinos have had the least success in picking the right players, and the Monkeys, Puffers and Goo have had the most success. Team Blanstein and the Oysters have been successful despite leaving points on the bench, and the Dogs have been picking the right players in a futile effort.

Player Moves – To evaluate who has made the best player moves, I calculated the total scoring of the originally drafted players, and divided that by the total scoring. This will have a bias for position (for example, if you drafted a backup quarterback and dropped him for a defensive team, your scoring will be reduced) and injuries.

Total Scoring - this is the sum of the total points scored by all your players through game 7, including starters and bench scoring.

Rank - this is the rank of your total scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest. This is a measure of how good your draft was so far in the season.

Original Draft Scoring - this is the sum of the points each week scored by the team that you originally drafted, including starters and bench scoring.

Rank - this is the rank of your original draft team scoring, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest.

Percent of Original - this is the percentage of points actually scored versus the original drafted team. A percentage greater than 100% indicates that your player moves improved your team overall. A percentage below 100% indicates that your player moves actually worsened your team.

Rank - this is the rank of your percentage, with 1 being the strongest and 10 being the weakest.

Some interesting notes:

- The Snails have improved themselves the most from the draft, scoring a huge 36% more than the originally drafted players. Eight teams improved, and one team declined (the Monkeys) from their originally drafted team, with the Goo making no changes.

Coaching Effectiveness

Overall Coaching Effectiveness – to calculate the overall coaching effectiveness, I added the ranks for each of the three categories for each team, and ranked overall based on the sum.

Team Blanstein overall show the most effective coaching, principally because of the powerhouse draft and some timely pickups, and despite leaving a lot of scoring on the bench (isn't that scary). Blanstein is closely followed by the Monkeys and the Oysters, and then a three-way tie for fourth between the Heaving Puffers (I can't believe they ever agreed to that name), Goey Black Death from Above, and the Squatting Dungbeetles. The Nancy Boys trail the category, despite some significant improvements, with the penultimate position held by both the Rhinos and the perennial Dogs, primarily because of lack of improvements. The Wandering Snails have made the most improvement, but with their draft, that's not saying a lot (just kidding [not really, but who am I to talk?]).
